

Who can help me make my home energy efficient?



A new role is emerging in the building world - the retrofit professional.

These are the people who understand how to future proof your home so it is energy efficient, comfortable to live in and saving you loads of money on your energy bills.

Retrofit Advisor: Provides guidance on retrofit options and energy efficiency measures. They'll talk with you about the different options and the factors you need to consider.

Retrofit Assessor: Comes to your home to do a full assessment of what needs to be addressed and how. This is where you'll get answers about your condensation issues, the cold spots in your house and whether you could have an air source heat pump.

Retrofit Coordinator: This is the person who will get in amongst it with the builders, architects etc and project manage your retrofit to make sure it is all done correctly. They will also ensure you are using the correct materials for your house

Retrofit Designer: Develops and implements retrofit designs, including building systems and technologies.

Retrofit Evaluator: Measures the impact of retrofit measures on energy consumption and building performance.

If you want help through the whole process, you may be able to find a Retrofit Coordinator who is also qualified as an Assessor so can take you through the whole process.
